



The office of the Indiana State Chemist and Seed Commissioner will be holding their annual Indiana Pesticide Clean Sweep Project again this year. The City of Washington's Household Hazardous Waste Facility will be participating and opening up the project to county residents. The project will collect and dispose of suspended, canceled, banned, unusable, opened, unopened or any unwanted pesticides (weed killers, insecticides, rodenticides, fungicides, miticides, etc.).

**What:** Indiana Pesticide Clean Sweep Project

**When:** All pesticide forms must be in by **Monday, July 30, 2018**. You can email them to the City of Washington Wastewater / Stormwater Department at [aquast@washingtonin.us](mailto:aquast@washingtonin.us) or bring them into the Wastewater office at 169 S 200 W from 7:00 am - 3:00 pm.

**Where:** The drop off location for your pesticides will be at the HHW facility located at 304 E. Oak St. Dates available for you to drop off your pesticides are Wednesday, August 15th and Thursday, August 16th, 2018.

This project only allows us to bring 250 pounds for each individual, if you have more than that you will have to take it to one of the drop off sites listed on the Indiana State Chemist website yourself. All containers must be labeled, leak free and safe to transport. Do **NOT** mix materials.

**Dates to Remember:** Your list of chemicals must be in to the Wastewater / Stormwater Department by **Monday, July 30, 2018**. Available dates to drop off your chemicals are **Wednesday, August 15th and Thursday, August 16th, 2018**.
